And by the Joint Resolution of 1882, supra, it was made, as provided in the Constitution of this state, that no claim could be granted against the heirs or devisees of a decedent except by and before the probate of the decedent's will and that if the will contained a gift of or for the benefit of a particular person the same was to be interpreted according to the laws of distribution and not according to the intent of the testator. This state has since been cited for the construction of wills and its laws have been accorded by the courts of other states, and the authorities there cited. Among them are *In re Wood's Estate*, 77 Kan. 611, 95 P. 871, 2 L.R.A.,N.S. 836, where it was said: "In construing a will, and ascertaining the intention of the testator, and, also, when construing the words of a will, all parts of the same must be construed, if possible, together and harmoniously, as a unit." and *Martin v. Callaway*, 133 Miss. 37, 97 So. 709, where the court said: "It is the duty of the court to construe a will so that all of its parts will stand together if such construction is possible." In the case at bar, if the will of April 4, 1929, had been executed by decedent exactly as written, it would have made a gift of the stock to one of the sons, and would have been self-executing to that extent, unless some person could legally interpose in a suit in the State District Court. But the will in question was an attempt to avoid the law that required delivery to the executor or administrator of a deceased person of all his
